LEONARDO BARILARO RELEASES NEW MUSIC VIDEO 'STORM'

*Multi-talented musician/aerospace engineer, Leonardo Barilaro, has released a new music video, 'Storm', inspired by his larger project – **SeaSharp**.*

Filmed at the Ras Il-Qammieh (an old radar station past the Red tower in Mellieha), 'Storm' is an expression of conflicting emotions one experiences in life. Described as being the expression of 'different versions of ourselves spinning continuously, fighting and dancing together', the experimental project has a complex and layered delivery both in its movement and sound.

The carefully choreographed movements of Venezuelan dancer Genesis Jimenez employs the use of three different choreographies based on postmodern techniques. This is complemented by Leonardo's use of both piano and synth played live at the same time – again adding another layer to the complex nature of 'Storm'.

Although 'Storm' is the brainchild of Leonardo, the piece also features the grooves and beats of international drummer and percussionist, **Randolf Jimenez** – working out of Toronto, Canada. It was also mixed and edited by sound engineer Paolo Bernardini and video maker Massimo Toniato – both from Italy.
